## **203.2 ORDER OF THE REGULAR SCHOOL BOARD MEETING**

### **I. PURPOSE**

The purpose of this policy is to ensure consistency in the order of business at regular school board meetings.

### **II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY**

It is the policy of the Floodwood School board to consider matters that come before it in a consistent and orderly manner.

### **III. ORDER**

- A. The school board shall conduct an orderly school board meeting. The school board will, at all regular school board meetings, follow an agenda order similar to:
  - 1. Call to order and roll call of attendance.
  - 2. Approval of agenda.
  - 3. Audience recognition.
  - 4. Consideration of Consent Agenda
    - 4a. Correction and approval of minutes of preceding meeting.
  - 5. Reports to the Board
  - 6. Administration
  - 7. Finance
  - 8. Activities Committee
  - 9. Facilities Committee
  - 10. Personnel Committee
  - 11. World's Best Work Force Committee
  - 12. Policy
  - 13. Meeting Announcements
  - 14. Adjournment
- B. Items in this order may be considered as part of the consent agenda.
- C. The school board may depart from the order of business with the consent of the majority of members present.
