

Department of Parks, Recreation and Social Services Policies

- Individuals who qualify as Old Bridge Residents are those who reside in Old Bridge Township. All other individuals are considered non-residents and must follow non-resident registration dates.
- Old Bridge residents are given registration priority for all programs listed in this brochure with the exception of tennis & ice arena programs. Non-residents may register on a space available basis.
- The Parks and Recreation department maintains a no refund policy. The only exception to this is for a medical reason and must be accompanied by a doctors note.
- All age requirements should be met by the first day of class, except where otherwise noted. Registrations which do not meet age requirements by the first day of class will not be accepted. Exceptions may be made however will be determined on a case by case basis.
- The Recreation Department reserves the right to cancel any program due to low registration numbers. In the event of this happening, the participants will be notified and offered the option of enrolling in another available class or receiving a refund.
- No unregistered persons are allowed in the classroom while programs are running. This includes, but is not limited to, children of adult participants and siblings.
- Only individuals classified by a child study team are eligible for participation in R.O.B.I.N. programs.
- On-line registration is available for participants of our recreation programs, please take advantage of this opportunity as openings in classes fill quickly.



Recreation in Old Bridge for those In Need

For over 30 years, Camp ROBIN has provided a recreational program for those with special needs in the community. The Camp ROBIN building at Geick Park aims to improve the recreational skills, socialization, independence and overall quality of life of those participating.

We offer many structured recreational programs utilizing experienced staff. The programs are designed specifically to meet the needs of individuals of all with developmental and/or physical disabilities. A variety of programs are offered during the Fall and Spring. Some of our most popular Recreational activities include yoga, chorus, basketball, and Friday Night Fun. Friday Night Fun is a program to enhance socialization skills, develop friendships and provide learning and entertainment opportunities for those ages 13 and up.

We offer 3 sections based on age for Friday night Fun, which is a trip based program. Our Teen program is for those ages 13-20. Our Young Adult program is for those 21-30. Everyone over the age of 30 participates in our Adult program. Transportation is available for those residents participating in our Adult program only. Young Adults & Teens participants are required to be dropped off and picked up at the Camp Robin building.

We also offer a Summer Day Camp for participants ages 7-21. Monday thru Friday during the week, campers go out 4 of the 5 days to activity locations such as bowling, movies and the beach. Please note-transportation

PLEASE NOTE

All new families to Camp Robin must do the following as part of the registration process:

- Register for a Camp Robin Intake where the Camp Robin coordinator will set up an appointment to meet with the family and participant for an interview to determine if Camp Robin can meet the individual's needs.
- Complete a Participant Profile Registration Form which needs to be on file in order to assist staff in better meeting your child's individual needs.
- A copy of your child's IEP or ISP must be submitted prior to being accepted into the program.
- All new participants, once accepted into Camp Robin, begin on a trial-basis.

All Participants are expected to follow basic rules of safety and interaction, have a moderate level of independence with toileting, feeding, personal care needs, and easily understand and follow simple directions within their group.
