SCHOOL DISTRICT FERPA NOTIFICATION AND OPT OUT FORM

Student Directory Information

Directory information is information contained in an educational record of a student that would not generally be considered harmful or an invasion of privacy if released.

In compliance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), this serves as the annual public notice to parents or eligible students (at least 18 years of age or who are attending an institution of post-secondary education) of the District's definition of directory information, the parent or eligible student's right to opt out of the release of student directory information, and the time period to opt out in writing. Following public notice and a reasonable response period, the District may release directory information without individual consent.

The primary purpose of directory information is to allow the District to include this type of information from the student's education records in certain school publications. Examples include: a playbill, showing a student's role in a drama production; the annual yearbook; honor roll or other recognition lists; graduation programs; and sports programs, such as for wrestling, showing weight and height of team members.

The District may also release directory information to outside organizations that include, but are not limited to, companies that manufacture class rings or publish yearbooks.

Student ID number or other unique personal identifier that is displayed on a student ID badge, but only if the identifier cannot be used to gain access to education records except when used in conjunction with one or more factors that authenticate the user's identity, such as a PIN, password, or other factor known or possessed only by the authorized user.

Opting-out

If you do not want the District to disclose directory information	n from your child's education records
to any parties for any purposes, other than those required by law,	without your prior written consent,
you must notify your child's building principal in writing by **	.

Parents and eligible students **may not**, by opting out of disclosure of directory information, prevent a school from:

- 1) Disclosing or requiring a student to disclose the student's name, identifier, or school email address (if any) in a class in which the student is enrolled; or
- 2) Requiring a student to wear or present a student identification card or a badge that displays information that may be directory information.
