MISSION:

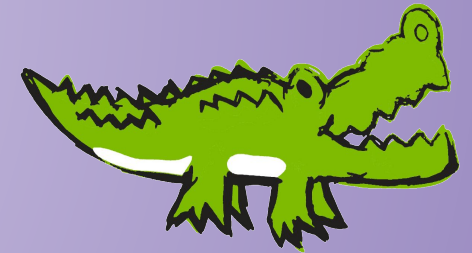
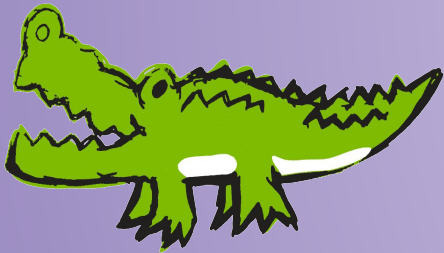
We will do whatever it takes to achieve excellence for all learners in all areas.
