Vision:

- In honor of Bernie Bahr, a champion of forestry resource management; this award will be awarded to a student who will make contributions to this field.
- This scholarship is for the student who has completed 50 college credits and is committed to obtaining a Bachelor's degree in Forestry, Natural Resources or a related field, such as Plant/Soil/Environmental Sciences.

Payment:

- \$1000 payable at the beginning of the fall semester. It must be used within two years of the application date.
- Scholarship money will be paid directly to the school when the recipient has provided proof (class schedule) they are enrolled in a relevant program.
- RENEWAL: Recipient may apply again.

Scholarship Guidelines:

- Complete application (with all attachments) to the Gasconade County R-1 Alumni Association Scholarship Chair, c/o Herman High School Admin Office, 176 Bearcat Xing, Hermann MO 65041 or via email to alumni@hermann.k12.mo.us, received no later than June 15.
- Completion of 50 or more credit hours (may have been taken during high school) with a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale. Grade reports may be used to indicate number of credit hours and GPA. (Does not have to be an "official" transcript).
- Acceptance and enrollment in an accredited college program for a Bachelor's degree in Forestry or Natural Resources (or closely related degree such as Plant/Soil/Environment Sciences). Agriculture and Crop Management does not qualify, as the donor's passion is for the conservation of natural resources.
- Graduation from Hermann High School or another high school in Gasconade, Montgomery, Warren or Calloway counties in Missouri.
- The Bahr Scholarship will be awarded annually.
