Goal 1: Continued academic improvement, improve math and reading readiness

Strategies:

- 1. Reading proficiency will increase with an emphasis on non-fiction reading across the curriculum.
- 2. Students, which are identified as having indicators of dyslexia, will have the opportunity to receive interventions provided by a certified teacher with training in strategies.
- 3. Interim testing will be utilized throughout each quarter to monitor student progress and grade level readiness.
- 4. Offer tutoring and ACT prep services before and after school.

Goal 2: Prepare students for college and career readiness

Strategies:

- 1. Provide chromebooks to all students and ClearTouch panels in classrooms to provide digital learning for all students.
- 2. Hiring a career coach to connect students to college and career opportunities.
- 3. Building relationships with members of the community to promote diverse post secondary educational opportunities for students.

Goal 3: Continually development of highly qualified teachers to carry out quality classroom instruction.

Strategies:

- 1. Teachers will utilize professional development through a variety of avenues to meet students' needs: completing the required Arkansas Science of Reading pathways, attending professional development based on new Arkansas math standards, and attending end of course ATLAS training.
- 2. Administration working with teachers to develop individualized professional growth plans to support teacher growth and development.
- 3. Equipping teachers with technology and current curriculum tools to support the adoption of new curriculum standards
