8.01 Grade/Jr. High School Principal, Mrs. Merboth:

Henry-Senachwine Grade & Jr. High School Principal Report September 20, 2023

- Henry-Senachwine Grade & Jr. High School currently has 406 students in grades PreK-8 enrolled for the 23-24 school year. There are two new students starting next week and 4 outplaced students.
- In addition to the HVAC and Roofing Projects over the summer, we updated and reorganized some internal spaces to enhance the educational environment. All curricular resources were organized into a book room and readily accessible for all staff to utilize for instruction. The conference room was cleaned out, painted and updated to provide a welcoming environment for meetings to be held. The JH wing hallway received a fresh coat of paint, including the lockers. The primary wing classrooms received a fresh coat of paint as well. The hallway behind the office was cleaned out to provide storage space for office supplies and houses an additional work area for pulling students to work with individually.
- Baseball and Softball seasons have come to an end. Baseball ended with a great comeback and fight till the end in the Regional game. Softball ended with a hard loss in the Regional Championship. Girls Basketball practices began the week of September 11th and games are right around the corner beginning September 25th.
- HSGS/JH students began Fall MAP Benchmark testing on September 18th. We will have our first round of Data Team Meetings on October 3rd to review the data.
- 5th Graders are enjoying a 6-week Gardening Club unit. The University of Illinois Extension Office comes once a week to engage the students in gardening.
- Staff participated in a School Improvement Day on September 15th. Dr. Miller reviewed ALICE training and the Threat Assessment Plan with staff. A lockdown drill with police is scheduled for September 22nd and Fire Drill on September 28th. K-2 teachers are piloting the new Go Math and 5-8 teachers are piloting the Into Math program for the 23-24 school year. A representative from Houghton Mifflin Harcourt joined to provide some introductory training and answer questions. The Special Education department met to discuss new mandates, the NOC process, and department needs. Paraprofessionals met to review schedules, duties, and job roles and responsibilities. Mentors and Mentees checked in with each other. Preschool met to work on Proof of Income documents and score the Dial Assessment. Mrs. Moberg provided MAP training for new staff.
- 4th Grade students attended Band Instrument Checkout on September 18th. JH Band and Choir students will enjoy a Band/Choir Activity Night on September 22nd 5-7 PM.
- HSGS/JH is amping up Cardinal Character. Students participated in expectation rotations on September 1st. Expectation posters have been displayed throughout the building. Character lesson flipbooks and access to the Character Counts Website were purchased for staff. Weekly lessons will be taught during a homeroom time that was built into the daily schedule. A wall of awesomeness is displayed in the entryway and two students from each homeroom will be selected each month to be recognized for showing good character. Congratulations to the September students of the month. K-5 students will earn Quarterly Celebrations and JH students will earn effort and conduct
