Daktronics Scholarship Criteria

Daktronics will award a \$1000 scholarship to the top 5 Gold Medal All-State Team winners who are majoring in a preferred major AS **IDENTIFIED BY DAKTRONICS** and attending an in-state college. The scholarships will be paid directly to the college or university the recipient is attending. To receive the scholarship, *students must attend a South Dakota college or university*. In the event that one of the top 5 Gold Medal All-State Team member is attending college outside of South Dakota, that scholarship will be awarded to the highest ranking member of the Gold Medal First All-State Team or Silver Medal Second All-State Team. Bronze Medal Third All-State Team members will be awarded scholarships in order of ranking should members of the Gold and Silver team members declare they are attending an out-of-state college.

PLEASE NOTE that all students will be judged for Academic All-State regardless of in or out of state college and major; that the \$1000 Scholarship portion utilizes the in state and preferred majors component. A student can be awarded Academic All-State and not qualify for the \$1000 scholarship.
