

ANNOUNCEMENT

The Bartholow Brothers Educational Charitable Trust will accept scholarship applications until March 31, 2024. Applications will be accepted from 2024 graduating seniors, with preference for students who live in Lyman County and are not in the top ten percent of their class.

Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of financial need, work ethic, goals, and character. Scholarships will only be for institutions of higher education located within the state of South Dakota. Such institution may be a college or university, or a technical, trade, or business school.

The 2024 scholarships will be for \$5000.00 each. A total of at least eight scholarships will be awarded for 2024. This total includes alumni scholarships and at least four scholarships for 2024 graduating seniors.

Applications are available at the office of the guidance counselors at Lyman High School, Chamberlain High School, and Lower Brule High School.
