Maintenance Worker

Reports To: Operations Manager

Length of Assignment: 12 months (dependent upon budget)

Tour of Duty: 7:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. Monday – Friday (Supervisor may assign an alternate tour of duty)

Employment Status: Hourly/Non-Exempt

Primary purpose: The Maintenance Worker will perform preventative maintenance and repair duties to ensure that all school buildings, school housing, and outlying buildings are maintained, kept in good repair and will provide a safe environment for students, staff and tenants. Will transport students as required; Non-CDL Driver will operate a passenger SUV.

Responsibilities: Duties of this job include, but are not limited to:

- 1. Receives work schedules from Lead Facilities Maintenance Man; and will establish own routine maintenance schedules
- 2. Performs preventative maintenance by doing minor repairs to plumbing fixtures, i.e., leaking faucets, pipes, clogged drains, dishwashers (school kitchen); install commodes, sinks
- 3. Repairs electrical outlets, changes light bulbs, lighting ballasts, light switches; installs bathroom fans; can do minor HVAC duties, minor maintenance on heating equipment, maintenance on
- 4. Repairs damaged floors, replaces tile, assists with minor construction projects i.e., building decks, porches, hanging drywall, painting classrooms, tenants' houses
- 5. Replace windows, window screens, repairs, and installs interior and exterior doors, screen doors, installs locksets, deadbolts
- 6. Cleans up job site, keeps all tools and equipment in good working condition; notifies Supervisor of any supplies needed to complete assignments; maintains an inventory of supplies and lets the Lead know when inventory needs replenishing
- 7. Is required to maintain records by keeping track of work tickets completed to include all time and materials used in performing the tasks.
- 8. Will transports students daily, according to daily routes assigned; may be asked to perform additional transportation assignments, i.e., after school activities.
- 9. Performs other duties as assigned.

Qualifications

- Must possess a High School Diploma or GED certificate
- Demonstrated experience in various trades, but can be lower than a journeyman level.
- Working knowledge of minor maintenance and repair of to keep buildings in good repair.
- Must be able to adhere to safety procedures to do physical risks
- Requires frequent lifting, moving, carrying, pushing, pulling of 50 lbs or more.
- Requires frequent standing, walking, stooping, kneeling, and crouching
- Work may involve exposure to unusual elements and extreme temperatures.
- Must possess/obtain and maintain a legal driver's license.
- Must be able to pass a physical as required by Personnel Policies and Procedures
