

FINAL EXAMS



EVERYTHING STUDENTS NEED TO KNOW ABOUT FINALS WEEK...

Exemption Policy

- Only courses that are taken for high school credit are eligible for exemption.
- Students with an "A" average and have 10 or less unexcused absences for the semester are exempt from taking the exam. No AP
 classes or Civics classes are exempt. Students with a "B" average and have 5 or less unexcused absences in a course are
 exempt from final exams.
- Semester exams exemptions will be communicated to students on Thursday, December 11th
- Students will earn an "M" if they fail to take the exam, which counts as a 0% if not taken.

Make Up Exams

Make up exams should be scheduled with the teacher. Please meet with your teacher as soon as possible if you are unable to take your exams during your regularly scheduled periods.

7th and 8th Graders Will Take An Exam

7th and 8th grade courses are not exempt from semester exams. Semester exams are worth regular assessment grades. Lunch and breakfast will be served during normally scheduled times.

Campus Access & Student Check In/Out

Students need to attend school for the purpose of taking their final exams. They may arrive late or leave early depending on exam exemptions. It

is the student's responsibility to arrive on time for the exams they are required to take. If the student arrives for the exam period, they are required to stay in class for the duration of the period (whether or not they are exempt from the exam.) You may check out your child through our normal early check out procedure. If you would like to make your 9th grade child a walker during finals week, please contact Ms. Marquez or Mrs. Washington.

What is 40-40-20?

Semester grades are calculated as the sum of 40% of the first quarter grade, 40% of the second quarter grade, and 20% of the final exam grade.

(If a student is exempt from their final, the 20% will be an average of their first and second quarter grades.)

(First Quarter % x 0.4) + (Second Quarter % x 0.4) + (Final Exam % x 0.2) = Semester Grade

Example

My child has to take the chemistry exam. They received an 85% first quarter and a 75% second quarter. They made an 80% on the final exam. The 85% from the first quarter will count for 40% of the final grade and the 75% from the second quarter will count for 40% of the final grade. The 80% from the final exam will count for 20% of the final grade. The student's final grade will be an 80%.

(85 x 0.4) + (75 x 0.4) + (80 x 0.2) = 80%

Final Exams will be from December 14-19. Make-up exams will be on December 20.

Dismissal Guidelines



Drop-Off/Pick-Up Zone Guidelines

- . Drivers are to stay in the car. Staff & volunteers will assist students out of the cars.
- · Be ready to load and unload quickly
- Be mindful of which side the students should exit the car from:
- Third Street: Right Side
- . Do not use the streets immediately around eStem to get to the drop-off/pick-up points; you will need to start several blocks away to help ease traffic congestion.
- Do not block intersections or crosswalks.
- Be mindful of all pedestrians.
- Pull forward as far as possible.
- . Do not park in the alley or the northbound lane of Louisiana.
- If you have multiple students attending eStem, Your car rider location is based on the youngest student's grade. **If the youngest sibling is in K-3 grade and listed as a car rider, any Jr. High siblings will be escorted to and dismissed from the Elementary building. If the youngest sibling is in 4-6 grade with a Jr. High sibling and is listed as a car rider, those students (4-6) will
- ait for their Jr. High sibling before leaving together as walkers.







NOTES FROM THE NURSE

If your child has any cold or flu-like symptoms, please keep them home.

- Our district-wide policy states:
 - Any student who has 2 or more symptoms of illness including headache, sore throat, runny/stuffy nose, cough, diarrhea, fatigue, body aches, shortness of breath, chest pain, fever, etc. will be sent home. A fever does not have to be present in order to send a student home.
 - Any student that has these cold/flu symptoms must be picked up from school. Students should remain home until symptom and/or fever free for 48 hours without fever-reducing medication or as directed by their physician. The parent should consider contacting their physician for further instructions and notify the Director of any test results they may receive.
 - We encourage all students and family members, medically able, who are 12 years old or older to get their Covid vaccination.
