# Honor Graduate Requirements

- **Summa Cum Laude-** (4.25 or higher GPA) These students must also have completed a minimum of 8 A.P. courses. Students with this distinction will wear a Summa Cum Laude gold medal with a gold ribbon, gold honors cord, gold honors sash, and any academic club sashes, cords, or pins.
- **Magna Cum Laude-** (4.0 – 4.24 GPA) These students must have completed a minimum of 4 A.P. courses. Students with this distinction will wear the Magna Cum Laude gold medal with a blue ribbon, gold honors cord, gold honors sash, and any academic club sashes, cords, or pins.
- **Cum Laude -** (3.75 – 3.99 GPA) These students must have completed a minimum of 4 A.P. courses. Students with this distinction will wear the Cum Laude gold medal with a black ribbon, gold honors sash, gold honors cord, and any academic club sashes, cords, or pins.
- **STEM Scholar-** (3.5 – 3.74 GPA) Students with this distinction will wear gold cords and any honors pins.

**\*\*All honor graduates MUST graduate with 24 credits minimum.\*\***
