We've done it again!

Grand Traverse Academy has earned high national and metro area rankings in <u>U.S. News & World Report's</u> 2023 Best High Schools, in both the high school and charter categories. GTAHS ranks in the top 19.5 percent of the nearly 18,000 ranked public high schools in the nation, the top 10 percent of the 1,166 ranked Michigan high schools and #9 of the 147 charter high schools in Michigan. We have earned this recognition a total of eight times, including 2013, 2014, 2017, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022 and 2023.

Carpool notes

With two weeks of school under our belts, carpool has been very smooth! Just a couple reminders to keep it safe for students, parents and staff:

- When dropping off students in the south lot in the morning, please use the carpool lane. Idling at the edge of the parking lot causes congestion for drivers who are parking and creates a safety hazard for pedestrians.
- In the afternoon, parents of high school students may use the parking lot for pickup vs. going through the carpool lane. Be sure to park in a marked space vs. idling in the lot.
- Please observe the posted speed limit on school grounds and watch for pedestrians. As the mornings get darker, walkers will be harder to see.

With everyone's cooperation and understanding, we can continue to keep our carpool process smooth, efficient and safe for all!

Authorization needed for all medication

As we begin the new school year, please know that



according to state law, we must have a physician's authorization in order to administer prescription medication to your children at school, and a parent's authorization for overthe-counter medications

(including herbal homeopathic remedies). The only exception is over-the-counter cough drops, which students may carry with them at school as needed. Authorization forms are available in either office and can be faxed to and from the doctor's office if necessary. Completed forms should be dropped off in the office by a parent, along with the labeled medication. Thank you for your understanding.

WHAT WE DO:


- "Family Fun" events such as the back to school picnic, a fall fun event, movie nights, sledding, ice skating parties, etc.
