Attention, parents of college-bound students

Ten of Michigan's 15 public universities have announced an initiative to streamline the college admissions process, boost enrollment and help students to realize their educational potential. The Michigan Assured Admission Pact (MAAP) will admit high school graduates who have earned a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above on a 4.0 scale. Participating schools for Fall 2024 admission are Central Michigan University, Eastern Michigan University, Ferris State University, Lake Superior State University, Northern Michigan University, Oakland University, Saginaw Valley State University, University of Michigan-Dearborn, University of Michigan-Flint, and Wayne State University.
