Post-Secondary Carousel is an academic event for 11th and 12th grade students and parents to learn about the multiple post-secondary institutions available to students after high school graduation.

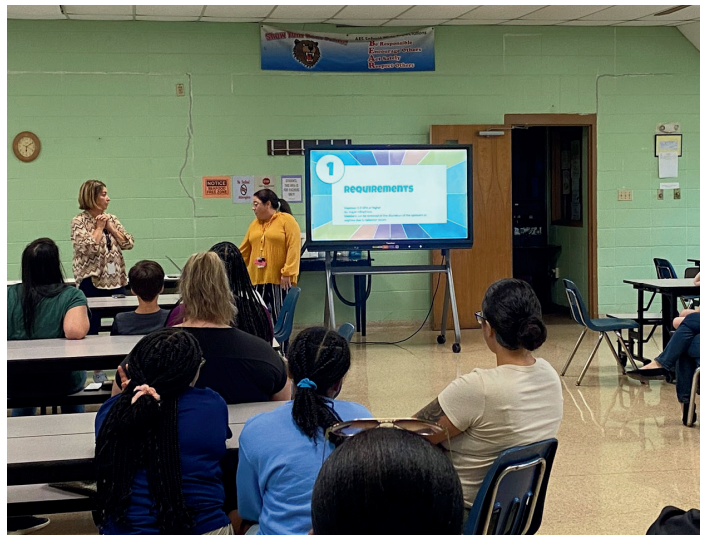
