Coach Dusty and Coach Bodin are teaching the students about bus safety and the proper way to evacuate during situations.



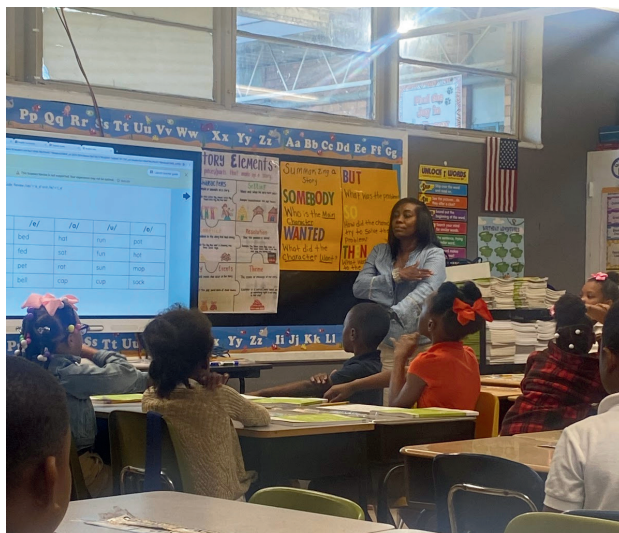
