# REGISTRATION GUIDELINES: IN-DISTRICT

\*Online classes- support held at CTE: Career and Technical Education Academy
4700 W Career Circle Sioux Falls, SD (I-29 North to Madison Street Exit)

\*Speech class & Team Sports (Physical Education) offered at CTE Academy

- \*\*Transportation for summer school is NOT provided. \*Buildings are closed Thursday, July 4th.
  - Online Courses: June 3 July 25
  - •In-Classroom Courses: Speech or Team Sports: June 3- June 26.

15-day session: Monday through Thursday from 7:30am to 12:30pm

### **CLASSROOM COURSEWORK**

Summer school content presented during the 15-day summer school session is equivalent to content presented during a full semester of school. Speech & Team Sports class is worth 0.5 credit and students are expected to attend EVERY class. If a student misses more than 2 classes, the student will be dropped from the course with an "F" grade. **Students will not be excused for family vacations, camps or similar activities**. Students who cannot commit to the required days for summer school should not register. Students who enroll in summer school must be able to benefit from instructional activities presented in groups with a ratio of 1 teacher to 20 or more students.

#### **CHROMEBOOKS**

Students will not need their school-issued Chromebooks for summer school. Laptops will be available for student use in the classroom.

### **ONLINE COURSEWORK**

Orientation for students enrolling in online classes for summer school will be <u>done via email</u> from your summer school teacher on or before Monday, June 3<sup>rd</sup>. \*Please be sure the student email you provide is the one to be used for orientation and coursework correspondence. The subject line of this email will read "Welcome to Summer School 2024" and will include your user name and password to begin your course. If you have not received an email contact from your summer school teacher by the end of the day on Monday, June 3rd, please call the CTE Academy at 605-367-5504 for more information.

A proctored final exam will be on or before July 25, 2024 from 7:30am-12:30pm. Students must also attend proctored unit exams at CTE throughout the summer as they work through the material. Online instructors will be available at scheduled times to administer **on-site unit exams** during regular summer school hours. Students will be allowed to advance through their course ONLY as they complete their unit exams. **Most coursework is completed independently by the student online**. **Teacher assistance will be available at CTE from 7:30am – 12:30pm (Monday- Thursday)**. **Buildings are closed Thursday, July 4.** Individual teachers will also schedule appointments for students who need additional help. All work must be completed by 12:30pm on July 25.

Because online work is very intense, **students may only register for one online course at a time** during the 8 week summer session. If all required work is completed in a shorter time frame, the summer school principal may authorize the student to take another online course upon teacher recommendation. **Computer Requirements:** To complete online work, students must have access to an Internet connection. School computers are available for student use at CTE Monday through Thursday, 7:30am to 12:30pm. Coursework is not compatible with iPad.

#### **In-District Registration Details**

- Students currently enrolled full-time in SFSD 49-5 (Lincoln, Jefferson, Roosevelt, Washington, Axtell, Ben Reifel, Edison, McGovern, Memorial, Patrick Henry & Whittier)
- Tuition is paid per half credit: Reduced pricing available for those qualifying for reduced and free lunch.
  - ✓ In-Classroom & Online: Registration deadline is May 24, 2024
  - ✓ Registration Fees: \$195 SFSD 49-5 enrolled in-district regular rate; \$145 SFSD 49-5 enrolled in-district reduced lunch rate;
    - or \$115 SFSD 49-5 enrolled in-district free lunch rate. Out of District student rate is \$280

Students can register for Speech or Team Sport in addition to ONE online course.

Students who successfully complete an Online Course and then gain the approval of the principal may enroll in an additional Online Course.

NOTE: \*\*There will be NO REFUNDS unless a course is canceled due to insufficient enrollment.\*

### **How to Register**

Register Online: After receiving approval from a school counselor, work with a parent/guardian to register online with a credit or check card. Visit <a href="https://www.comed.sf.k12.sd.us">www.comed.sf.k12.sd.us</a> and search for your course. Parents, when registering, click on "Enroll Someone Else" instead of "Enroll Myself" and enter student name, ID, student's best email for communications and coursework, and school information.

**Free and Reduced Rate Students:** Students who qualify for free and reduced lunch rates receive a discount on summer school registration. Please make sure "yes" is checked on the Information Disclosure form with the Child Nutrition Office to have eligibility status shared with the Summer School Office. Choose the appropriate fee.

If unable to register online, please contact your counselor for details or you may come to IPC at 201 East 38th Street with payment in full. \*Cash, check or money order in the exact amount only will be accepted.

All Students: Payments and Registrations will be verified daily and will be accepted in the order in which they were received.
