Under the Program, a \$1,500 scholarship will be awarded to seniors attending a high school in a city or town listed below served by OnCourse Insurance or where the OnCourse has a presence.

Available Scholarships:

Redmond School District: one (1) \$1,500 scholarship are available for seniors attending any high school in the Redmond School District.

North Wasco County School District: one (1) \$1,500 scholarship are available for seniors attending any high school in the North Wasco County School District.

Sherman County School District: one (1) \$1,500 scholarship are available for seniors attending any high school in the Sherman County School District.

Dufur School District: one (1) \$1,500 scholarship are available for seniors attending any high school in the Dufur School District.

South Wasco County School District: one (1) \$1,500 scholarship are available for seniors attending any high school in the South Wasco County School District.

Sisters School District: one (1) \$1,500 scholarship are available for seniors attending any high school in the Redmond School District.

Jefferson County 509J School District: one (1) \$1,500 scholarship are available for seniors attending any high school in the Redmond School District.

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

The OnCourse Foundation believes that everyone has a different course or path through life. Our hope is that we can help you find your course or path and help you along the way.

There are two Paths to obtain the OnCourse Foundation Scholarship. Path one is for a graduating senior who plans to attend a 4 year college or university and knows what they wish to study.

Path two is for the graduating senior that may not be attending a 4 year college or university, but has a clear path or direction that they want to pursue or do after high school to further their education or career path.

Course or Pathway #1

* Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 and plan to attend a 4 year college/university.

*Applicants must know their intended major, focus or trade they wish to pursue after high school.

Course or Pathway #2

* Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 and plan to join the workforce or attend a trade school.

*Applicants must develop a detailed plan including life goals, objectives and how they will use scholarship funds to help them achieve these goals.



All applicants must have the endorsement of their Guidance Counselor on their application attesting they are a qualified fit for this scholarship program. **OnCourse Foundation strongly suggests that each high school present this opportunity to the strongest applicants that match this program's guidelines.** Application deadline is **May 1st, 2024 by 4:00 p.m.** to be received if the Foundation. Late applications are not accepted.
