#### SCHOOL ELECTION IN MAY

Froid School will hold their school election on Tuesday, May 7, 2024. This year there will be two (2) board positions that will be up for election. Anyone interested in running for the School Board may pick up a Declaration of Intent and Oath of Candidacy form from the clerk of the school by March 28, 2024. This form must be filed with the clerk of the school, Joyce Harvey, by March 28 2024. Also, at this election the board anticipates holding mill levy elections for the general fund in both the elementary district and the high school district. The board anticipates holding a mill levy election in the elementary technology fund and the high school technology fund.

This past Monday, Feb. 19th, seven individuals competed in Farm Agriculture Management and Business (FAMB), Employment Skills, and Extemporaneous Speaking in the Sidney LDEs. The teams did well, and I am proud of them as they came out of their comfort zone to compete. The FAMB Team did very well, pulling out a third-place team score. The team was consistent, and although no individual pulled off a top three, they all did well and accumulated enough points for the team's third-place finish. Employment skills was a tough competition, and it took the competitors out of their comfort zone, but over all they competed well. Froid had one individual compete in extemporaneous speaking; Cian Logan did very well with a 1st place finish. Sidney was the last district competition of the year, sweepstakes were announced in Sidney. Froid did well enough to pull off a third in the Big Muddy district in sweepstakes and is sending seven teams to state, livestock judging, vet science, sales, floriculture, mechanical, agronomy, FAMB, and one extemporaneous speaker to state, a total of 13 students. The state is in Billings April 2-6 this year, and we have an air BnB reserved.
