Attendance Matters:

Chronic absenteeism for our school means missing more than 20 school days in a calendar year. This is actually quite a bit of school and over time can greatly affect a child's ability to be successful in school.

We have a number of students that are approaching 20. Therefore, we will be scheduling meetings to discuss options to help families get their child to school.

If attendance does not improve then legally we have to file truancy charges with the county attorney. MCA 20-5-5106

We appreciate parents who keep their child at home when they are sick, and communicate with the school regarding these absences. To have a medically excused absence (one that does not count toward the 20 days) the school must have a doctor's note or make an arrangement with our schools' nurses. When reviewing attendance all of these factors are considered while following our multi-step truancy program.
