Hello! As we begin the new school year the dedicated team in the Cafeteria, aka the Cool School Café, is ready to provide meals for your children!

You will receive a 2023-2024 Free/Reduce Priced Meals Application with your school paperwork. Please take a moment to complete and return to school at your first convenience. The data from the forms is used to determine financial assistance for meals and other programs, like the P-EBT assistance cards for families. The USDA has discontinued Free meals for all students. The form will be needed to determine if your child is eligible for meal benefits at school. Lunch for Paid Rate students is \$3.25. There is no fee for students that qualify for Free or Reduced Rate. We are happy to tell you that Cape May City Elementary does provide breakfast at no cost to all students. If you have questions or need assistance with the form, please call. I am happy to help!

Daily Meal Offerings

- BREAKFAST AFTER THE BELL PROGRAM: Students arrive at school from 8:30-8:45AM. Breakfast is available in the classrooms for all students free of charge. Students will have to time to eat their breakfast after arrival time has concluded.
- Lunch is served in school everyday students are present, including early dismissal days.

The Menu

- Students may choose the featured lunch or the sandwich of the week. A variety of fruits and veggie choices, along with milk choices will be available to complete the lunch.
- Menus are available on the website under "Food Menu" for the daily menu or under "Documents" -Cool School Café to see the Monthly menu.
- A printed monthly menu will also be sent home to you.

Sending Payment

- Weekly and monthly prices will be listed on the menus.
- We use a computerized lunch program that will keep track of meal purchases and payments. If there is a balance due you will be provided with a notice. Students will not be denied lunch because of a balance due, although we appreciate payment in a timely manner.
- Payment of cash or check may be sent in with your child. Credit cards and online payments are not accepted at this time. Please make checks payable to CMCBOE Food Service
- Teachers will collect payment and meal choices from the students in the morning and send to the cafeteria.
