He also has presented a proposal called "WabanakiCore", to the Maine Culture and Education Subcommittee chair to Amend the Program of Studies. This will allow the Wabanaki High School Students to take courses in history and language arts that reflect the Wabanaki Culture and Language. There is a \$763,800 funding allocated to address air quality and HVAC. He also informed the school committee that the school community grant opportunity will be a five-year grant-funded opportunity to provide more culturally responsive programs to support the student's academic and emotional needs.
