These AmeriCorps national service positions will serve 40 hours per week Monday – Friday in person during school hours, after school, possible evening events and during some school breaks. The anticipated service term is January/February 2024 through July/August 2024. The Learning Advocate positions provide comprehensive academic support at both elementary and secondary schools.

There are two total positions available serving at the following schools—

- ☑ Harrah Elementary and Mt. Adams Middle School

These positions are a good fit for people who –

- ☑ Enjoy working on a team.
- ☑ Are comfortable working with children and adolescents.
- ☑ Have an interest in education and social work.
- ☑ Are US citizens, nationals, or lawful permanent resident aliens.

What you'll be doing –

- ☑ Tutor students in a school setting under the supervision of a certificated teacher.
- ☑ Lead afterschool and enrichment activities to support academic success.
- ☑ Provide academic support in classrooms as needed.
- ☑ Conduct check-in meetings with students who need academic success coaching.
- ☑ Organize learning materials and maintain student contact logs/records.

What you'll receive –

- ☑ Monthly stipend of \$2,380.95, paid bimonthly.
- ☑ Valuable experience in education.
- ☑ An education award of \$3,447.50.
- ☑ Access to basic healthcare, counseling, and career support services.
- ☑ Monthly Food Assistance (if eligible).
- ☑ Workers' compensation coverage.
- ☑ Subsidized childcare provided by GAP Solutions Inc. (if eligible).
- ☑ Student loan support including forbearance and interest accrual payment on qualifying loans and payment of interest on qualifying student loans that accrued during the service term (paid after successful completion of service term).
- ☑ Serving in a full-time AmeriCorps position qualifies as "employment" towards the Public Service Loan Forgiveness program.
