Complete all sections of the application including the 3-5 paragraph essay. Students need to ask two middle school teachers to complete the Teacher Recommendation forms which are included in the application packet. The teacher will then forward the form to Mrs. Fernandes, School Counselor at which point will complete the School Counseling Recommendation form. Mrs. Fernandes will then forward your completed application to Mrs. Bonetti in the School Counseling Office. Mrs. Bonetti will gather your academic records needed to complete your application. Your completed application will then be given to Mrs. Rubbo in the Agriculture Science Program.

Other parts of the application:

Teacher Recommendation Form - ask a teacher and provide them with this form so that they may complete it for you. Ask as early as possible to give your teachers enough time to complete the form. They will return the completed form to Mrs. Fernandes, School Counselor.

Personal Reference Form - the individual (non-relative) who completes this form may return the completed form back to you or to Mrs. Fernandes.

School Counselor Form - this form should be given to Mrs. Fernandes along with your completed application.

Release of Records - Your report card/transcript will be generated by the School Counseling Office if your application is complete and has all the required signatures.

Mandatory Applicant Parent Meeting - mandatory parent/guardian informational meeting scheduled on December 7, 2023 at 6pm in the Wamogo High School auditorium. Should there be inclement weather and school is closed or closes early, this meeting will be canceled. The make up date will be on December 14, 2023 at the same time and place.
