Pioneer Pleasant Vale 2023-2024 Safe Return and Continuity of Services Plan

Pioneer Pleasant Vale Public Schools has taken and will continue to take action to ensure the health and safety of all students and staff. A description of actions previously taken and the continuation of health and educational services are provided below. This plan was developed in conjunction with local and state health officials and created with input from school and community members.

- Traditional in-person learning will continue for the 2022-23 school year and remain in place as long as COVID-19 infections remain at a level that indicates that in-person learning is safe for students and staff.
 - Virtual learning option will only be continued for those students and parents who have special conditions or it is medically necessary.
 - Traditional calendar will be observed and can be found at www.ppv.k12.ok.us
 - Staff will continue with increased cleaning of school buildings and buses.
 - Students and staff will continue to be encouraged to hand wash and have access to hand sanitizers.
 - Temperatures may be checked upon entering school buildings. Individuals with symptoms of COVID-19, such as a fever of 100 degrees or more, may not enter.
 - Visitor access will be limited. The school board has authorized the administration to change this if conditions change.
 - Parents will be contacted if students exhibit symptoms of illness while at school.
 - Staff members have received information regarding vaccines.
 - Appropriate accommodations for students with disabilities are provided on a case by case basis so that the individual needs of the student may be addressed.
 - Pioneer Pleasant Vale Schools will follow state law regarding masks. Please refer to the school board policy regarding masks at www.ppv.k12.ok.us
 - Pioneer Pleasant Vale Public Schools will provide summer school and extended school year services if needed. During the school year, students will continue to be assessed, monitored and instructed based on their learning needs. Feedback will be provided to students and parents.
 - The district will increase services to address social-emotional learning and mental health needs through partnerships with local counseling organizations.
- * Once a student has missed school due to Covid-19, that student must provide a written statement from a doctor or approved medical facility that clears the student for return to school. At home tests will not be accepted.
