



3000 - Finance 310 - Political Contributions

1. Policy

No funds or assets of the Providence Hall Charter School (PHCS) may be used by or contributed to any political party, organization (e.g. PAC), or to any individual who either holds public office or is a candidate for public office. Following are examples of prohibited activities:

- 1.1. Donations made by PHCS to political campaigns or PACs
- 1.2. Purchase of tickets by PHCS for political fundraising events
- 1.3. Political contributions or expenses made by an employee that are then submitted for reimbursement to PHCS (or any other type of submission)
- 1.4. In-kind contributions, such as lending employees to political parties or using PHCS' assets in political campaigns. PHCS Facilities may be used to host "town hall" or other meetings where all candidates are invited/eligible to attend and participate fully in the meeting
