It is made up of men and women who are living or working in the Sutherlin area and are committed to improving our community and fulfilling our motto of "**We Serve**". Because of this, your acts of service to your community are an important part of this application. Also, since our organization seeks to serve those who are unable to do so on their own, your financial need will also be closely looked at.

Application Deadline: April 15, 2024

- 1. The following items are prime considerations in reviewing your application.
 - a. What your future plans are and what school you are planning to attend.
 - b. How you have impacted your community through your service to others,
 - c. Financial need,
 - d. Why you feel you deserve to receive this scholarship.
- 2. Include a comprehensive list of the following items during the last four years.
 - a. Community service (this is high on our considerations),
 - b. Recognition and Awards you have received during your school years,
 - c. High School Academic Transcript,
 - d. Extra-Curricular Activities.
- 3. Three letters of recommendation from people who can attest to your integrity, need and service; and their relationship to you (i.e. teacher, administrator, preacher, relative, employer, adult friend or recipient of your service).
- 4. A list of at least three other people we may contact who know of your accomplishments and personal integrity, other than those who have submitted a letter of recommendation.

Please be advised, that if you should become a recipient of our scholarship, the funds must be used within one year of your receiving it.

We wish you well in your future, and hope that you will always consider how you may serve others in need.
