Old School Building
Demolition Information

The Crawford ISD Board of Trustees met in a workshop with architect Bruce Thacker on Monday, October 9. The purpose of this workshop was to discuss the next steps in the building demolition and classroom construction. Listed below are some very important pieces of information that will help answer some of your questions about the demolition process.

1. As soon as a date to begin demolition is established, that date will be posted on all district social media. At this point, we understand that demolition will begin sometime in December.
2. Anyone that wants to come up and take pictures outside the building is welcomed to do so. The preferable time for this would be outside the school day.
3. At the recommendation of our architect and structural engineer, no one is allowed to enter the building.
4. In an Update #5 Q&A, it was mentioned that some materials from the old building would be preserved if feasible. Also, some in our community have suggested trying to preserve certain items and include them in any new construction if possible. Certainly this will be considered, but it has to be considered within the scope of the overall bond budget.

The board and administration are making every effort possible to keep our community informed about the building progress. Please continue to watch our social media for new information as it comes available.
