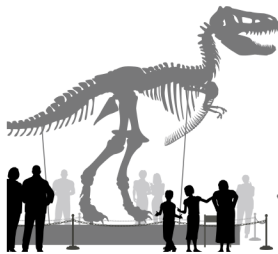

Warrant Article 25: Supporting Library Infrastructure

To see if the Town of Hampton will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$50,000 for the purpose of completing physical repairs to, and upgrading items at, the Lane Memorial Library, including repairing the portico area, installing an interior wall and door with associated work as well as to implement certain IT upgrades.

REPAIRING PORTICO



During rain storms, the library entrance leaks from the roof and automatic doors down into the staff kitchen below. These leaks have consistently caused water damage to the ceiling tiles and created safety concerns with wet floors and counters. Warrant Article 25 will allow us to repair these leaks to prevent further damage.

ADDING OFFICE



The current library director's office is defined by two privacy screens. Warrant Article 25 will allow us to add a solid door and walls to maintain privacy and minimize distractions.

MIGRATING HISTORIC WEBSITE



With funds from Warrant Article 25 we will complete the migration of historic content from the old library website to the new one. This will make historical resources more accessible to the public. It will also allow us to house all content in one secure digital location, that will be reliable into future.
