**Introduction**

Welcome to Deer Park School's Crash Zone. Crash Zone is our before and after school program that is designed to give the students of Deer Park School a safe place to go and meet the needs of working parents. We provide a safe, fun, active environment for any current Deer Park student.

**Before School Program**

**Days:** Monday - Friday

**Time:** 7:00 a.m. - 8:00 a.m.

**Location:** Back of Quonset hut

**Cost**

Crash Zone is meant to be an affordable place for parents to send their children before and after school. Prices are dependent on your free/reduced status.

**Morning Crash Zone**

**7:00-7:45**

**Full price:** \$2.00 for 1 student; \$4.00 per family (2 or more students)

**Reduced:** \$1.00 for 1 student; \$2.00 per family (2 or more students)

**7:45-8:00:** Free

**Afternoon Crash Zone:**

**3:20-3:45/Wednesdays-2:35-3:00:** Free

**3:45-6:00:**

**Full price:** \$6.00 for 1 student; \$10 per family (2 or more students)

**Reduced price:** \$3.00 for 1 student; \$6.00 per family (2 or more students)

Crash Zone is billed on the 5th every month. Payment is due within 30 days of the billing date. If payment is not received, the student will not be admitted into Crash Zone until the bill is paid.

### **Hours of Operation**

Mon, Tues, Thurs, Fri: 7:00-8:00 a.m. and 3:20-6:00 p.m.

Wednesday: 2:35-6:00 p.m.

The before and after school Crash Zone will follow the Deer Park School District school calendar as well as closures due to inclement weather or hazardous conditions.

### **Registration and Enrollment**

There are Crash Zone registration forms in the school office.

### **General Illness Policy**

Your child may be sent home when the following symptoms are present:

- Temperature of 100 degrees F or greater
- Vomiting or diarrhea
- Evidence of lice, nits
- Extreme pain due to earaches, headaches, toothaches, etc.
- Injury

### **Discipline/Safety/Sporting Events**

We will follow these safety guidelines:

- If there is chronically disruptive behavior or severe behavior, the parents/families may be called and asked to pick up their student. If the behavior continues, the student may be asked to not return to the Crash Zone.
- Parents/family members must come into the Crash Zone to pick up their students and sign out. For safety and security reasons, students will not be allowed to leave even if the parent/family member calls to announce their arrival and asks the student to meet them in the parking lot.
- Students will **not** be allowed to attend school sporting events while they are in Crash Zone unless the Crash Zone students go as a group with supervision or a permission slip is submitted to the Crash Zone aide. The sporting event permission slip must be filled out prior to the event and must be filled out for each event separately. One permission slip will NOT count for all sporting events.

### **Personal Property and Devices**

The students are responsible for their own backpacks, coats, boots, and other personal belongings. They will be expected to hang their coats and backpacks on the hooks provided.

**Devices such as tablets, cell phones, mp3 players, etc. are not permitted in Crash Zone.**

Parents can call the school and Crash Zone extension to contact their student and students will be allowed to use the school phone when needed.

**Snacks**

Crash Zone will provide snacks to students in Crash Zone. Students will also be allowed access to their own snacks if they choose. If your child has any food allergies or sensitivities, please inform the Crash Zone staff and they may need to provide their own snack.
