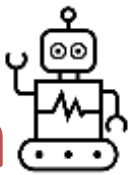
## Picture Retakes! October 20<sup>th</sup>

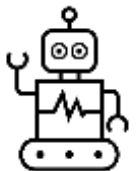

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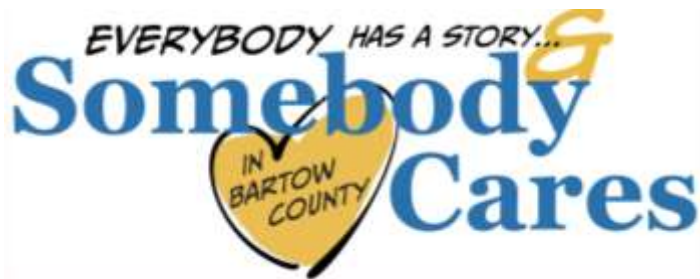
