School Reports

- All schools began SOAR Tutoring on September 18th. The program is from 7:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., most Mondays, breakfast and lunch are being provided on Mondays through a community donation. Certified teachers are providing the tutoring at each campus.
- Umpire School: Grades K-6 have an enrollment of 51 students, and grades 7-12 have an enrollment of 41. There are two new staff members on the Umpire campus. Three teachers are on ALPs and there is one long-term sub. Umpire School is dedicated to building strong foundations through enriching minds for each student, each day, and in every way.
- Cossatot River Primary—Kindergarten through 2nd grade has an enrollment of 170. CRPS utilizes Istation, IXL, Lexia, STAR Reading and Math, and Benchmark Universe for supplemental programs and remediation. Our mission, in partnership with the community, is to help children believe in themselves, respect others, and experience the joy of learning.
- Cossatot River Elementary—3rd through 6th grade has an enrollment of 221. CRES uses Istation Reading and Math, IXL, Benchmark Universe, STAR Reading and Math, Lexia Core 5 and PowerUp as remediation and supplemental programs. Cossatot River Elementary's mission is to positively impact the lives of all students and to provide an educational environment that promotes growth, success, and a lifelong love of learning.
- Cossatot River High School—7th through 12th grade has an enrollment of 383. Cossatot River High School is using STAR Reading for grades 7 and 8 and Get More Math and Zearn are both being utilized for remediation. The overall goals are to improve student achievement while maintaining a safe and healthy environment.
