

Jay Harris FFA Scholarship Application

This annual, non-renewable, \$500 scholarship was established to honor Jay Harris. Mr. Harris was the first Agriculture teacher and FFA sponsor at TMP-M.

Criteria

The applicant must:

- be a graduating senior at TMP-Marian High School.
- have been enrolled in at least two agriculture-related classes. Transfer students must provide proof of course of study at the previous high school.
- be a current member of the TMP-Marian FFA Chapter and must have been a member of the chapter for at least two years
- be admitted to, or plan to attend, an accredited post-secondary school full-time in the fall after their high school graduation. Eligible schools may include any accredited university, college, community college, or vocational-technical school.
- provide proof of enrollment which shows the name of the student, the name of the post-secondary institution, the semester and the students' class schedule for the fall semester. The full scholarship (\$500) will be paid directly to the recipient's school of choice upon proof of enrollment.

Application Instructions

The application must include:

- The application must be typed.
- a high school transcript with cumulative grade point average.
- a resume' which includes activities, service, leadership and community involvement.
- a 250 word essay describing your career and educational goals and how FFA has influenced these choices.
- One personal letter of recommendation from a person not involved in the school who can attest to your character, personal qualities and abilities. A family member is not acceptable.
- Complete applications must be returned to the school counselor by April 10.
