- List leadership positions held and with which organization/club.
- List awards you have received (academic, athletic, FFA, etc. including any “off campus” acknowledgments)
- Describe your participation in any civic or volunteer projects
- List your work experience.
- List hobbies or personal activities.
- State your educational/career goals for after graduation.
- State any other information which you would like to be considered.
