The Elkton School District serves approximately 240 students in two schools, located in Northern Douglas County, 38 miles North of Roseburg and about 30 minutes south of Cottage Grove. The local economy is one based on agriculture and forestry. Our location allows for an easy commute into Roseburg, Sutherlin Cottage Grove, Drain and Reedsport.

Elkton Schools are the hub of the community and serve as a gathering place for both school and non-school activities. Elkton School District enjoys the support of several community organizations. In 2019, the community approved a capital construction bond in the amount of \$3.2 million, which allowed the district to remodel part of the grade school, adding safety features and other upgrades. The district was able to also build a new gym and three Middle School classrooms.

Elkton High School has a dedicated team of teachers and classified personnel, both experienced and developing. The school boasts growing programs and a cadre of specialists supporting students and teachers in the areas of PE, Art, Music, Science, Math, Reading, and Social-Emotional Learning. Our programs continue to evolve and grow, and we look forward to better developing our Natural Resources based curriculum in the coming years.
