BUS SAFETY PROGRAM

The safety and welfare of student riders will be the first consideration in all matters pertaining to transportation. Safety precautions will include the following:

- 1. The Lake Forest School District's transportation program will meet all State of Delaware requirements such as for bus drivers, standards for buses, and maintaining safe speeds.
- 2. Emergency evacuation drills will be conducted regularly throughout the school year to familiarize student riders with procedures in emergency situations as per Delaware Department of Education regulations.
- 3. All vehicles used to transport children will be maintained in such condition as to provide safe and efficient transportation service.
- 4. As part of the District's school bus safety program, every effort will be made to equip buses with District-owned, fixed, full-time video camera recording systems. The main purpose of these systems is to monitor behavior during bus rides.
- 5. As part of the District's school bus safety program, every effort will be made to equip buses with District-owned Global Positioning Systems (GPS). The main purpose of these systems is to monitor bus travel paths, speeds, and stop data.
