The Child Nutrition Program will operate under the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) for this school year. CEP will allow Child Nutrition Services to provide nutritious meals at no cost to any of our students.

Students **WILL** still need money in their accounts if parents/guardians allow them to purchase any extras (seconds, snacks, cookies, ice cream, etc.).

Please note: As in previous years, your child's account balance will roll over to the new school year.

Payments to accounts can be made at the school cafeteria register with cash or check. Parents can also create an account online at [MYSCHOOLBUCKS.COM](https://myschoolbucks.com). They can use the account to look at the student balances (for free), or an online payment can be made to the student account for a fee of \$2.95 per transaction.
