Target Population

The Edcouch-Elsa Early College High School, in partnership with South Texas College, has a primary focus of affording students from underrepresented backgrounds the opportunity to earn 60+ college credit hours. Students are able to complete their college credit hours free of charge within the customary time frame that is required to complete a standard 4- year high school degree program. As a designated Early College High School, we are asked to target students of underrepresented backgrounds in an effort to provide ample academic opportunities for success; however, we encourage students of all backgrounds to apply and take part in our selection process that encourages and considers applications from all students. (All students have an equal opportunity for acceptance, regardless of background or academic performance.)

Campus Websites:

Our ECHS campus has a website and this is a primary form of communicating upcoming events, activities and important and relevant information regarding the students to include EC & STEM relating items.

Campus "At A Glance" Newsletter:

Our campus has a weekly school newsletter called "EEHS Week At A Glance" where we highlight academics, share sports, club information, photos, dates of events and activities. Newsletters are shared among all campus staff, Central office staff and support staff.

Staff REMIND:
