	 Every effort will be made to ensure that all special populations are represented (at risk, special education, bilingual, English as a second language, gifted and talented, title 1 regular, title 1 migrant) members shall be selected, elected, or appointed.
	Administrators, teachers, staff and business community members can serve on the committee. Coordination and integration of parental engagement strategies with the
	 Coordination and integration of parental engagement strategies with the Hidalgo County Head Start, and the Teaching and Mentoring Communities will be ongoing.
	There will be an annual evaluation of the content and effectiveness of the Title I Parental engagement program and parents will be asked for their input. The evaluation will include an assessment of how much parental engagement is increasing and what barriers to parental participation still need to be overcome. The school district will revise its Parental Engagement policy on the basis of this annual review.
