- o If a student does not make it into the choice program, the family will be notified in writing and will be given his/her ranking from the lottery.
- o The principal will notify the choice school of the acceptance or rejection of the choice program.

- o Assure that you district is able to enroll the student in line with regard to "caps" or agreement.
- o Contact parent/guardian of applicant to setup enrollment appointment.
