

5. Spending quiet time at home daily studying or reading.




As a **parent**, I will be responsible for...

3. Providing a time and place each evening for quiet study and reading without TV or other electronic devices.
4. Encouraging my child and being available for questions or help.
5. Staying aware of what my child is learning.
6. Reading with my child and letting my child read to me.
7. Meeting with my child's teacher to discuss my child's needs and performance in school.

As **teachers**, we will be responsible for...

1. Providing high quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that will help students to meet the state's student academic standards as they enjoy learning.
2. Encouraging students and parents by supplying frequent evaluations of student's achievement on Progress Reports and Parent/Teacher Conferences.
3. Explaining requirements such as the School-Parent Compact as part of the Parent Involvement Policy at the Annual Meeting, etc.
4. Being accessible for Parent Conferences, parent observations in the classroom, messages, opportunities for parents to volunteer, etc.
5. Providing assistance and support for parents to tutor at home.
6. Provide students and parents multiple forms of feedback in a timely manner.
