WHO CAN ATTEND

Any junior or senior student (Roosevelt & CTE students) may attend prom. **A student is permitted ONE GUEST or DATE (also known as a +1) for the dance.** If that guest/date is NOT a Roosevelt/CTE student, then a [Student Guest Form - SPRING 2024](#) (available in the Activities Office) must be completed prior to purchasing tickets. This form should not be used to invite additional friends from another school or graduates if you are already going to the dance with a Roosevelt student as a date (your +1). **If the student is not a Roosevelt/CTE student, please PURCHASE BOTH TICKETS AT THE SAME TIME as a pair of tickets.** Likewise, you must arrive together for check in.

TICKET SALES -- \$45 per person

Tickets are \$45 per person and will be **sold on April 3-10 during lunch periods** (10:20 a.m. through 12:40 p.m.). **Students who do not have a lunch period or are in CCP classes** during these times should contact Mrs. Dreher-Rodesheim or Mrs. Jurging about purchasing a ticket. There will be 10 people at a table for dinner. If students want to sit with their friend group, they are encouraged to buy their tickets together if possible. **STUDENTS MUST HAVE COMPLETED EMA ON FINAL FORMS in order to purchase a ticket.**

DINNER

A dinner is included with the price of the ticket and will include hors d'oeuvres (vegetable spring rolls, cheese board, and red pizza squares), salad bar, board-carved prime rib, grilled chicken, pasta marinara, and grilled vegetables.

PARKING & TRANSPORTATION

There is parking available at the party center for students who choose to drive. We will be providing transportation (school bus) for students who may need it. **Students who need transportation should request it by filling out the [Prom Transportation 2024 Google form](#).** Students riding the bus should be at Roosevelt by 5:20 for a 5:30 departure. At the end of the evening, the bus will depart from Todaro's at 10:00 p.m. and arrive at Roosevelt around 10:30. **Students who use school transportation must stay for the entire event and ride the bus both ways.**

ARRIVAL -- Between 6:00-6:25 p.m.

Because this year's prom is both a dinner and a dance, students who purchase the ticket are expected to attend both. Students should **plan to arrive between 6:00 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. Dinner will be served promptly at 6:30 p.m.**

PROM ATTIRE

Although formal attire is worn by a great majority of students, a tux and formal dress are not required for admittance to the Prom. Students need to keep in mind that Prom night is very special, and they need to dress accordingly. While Prom dress may vary greatly in reflection of current styles and fashion trends, there is an expectation that students should **refrain from wearing clothing that is excessively revealing or not in good taste** for a high school activity. **Theodore Roosevelt High School reserves the right to refuse admittance to any student or guest who is inappropriately dressed.**

BEHAVIORAL EXPECTATIONS

All school rules will be in effect. As is the case at all school dances, chaperones at the Prom will enforce Board of Education policy throughout the evening since the school is responsible for this activity. This includes dancing and behaviors that are considered inappropriate for a high school event. All students attending prom will be breathalyzed. Anyone attending Prom after having consumed alcohol, marijuana, or any chemical, or anyone being in possession of any of these, will be removed from the Prom. **This includes both Roosevelt students and their guests.** Such students will be suspended from school and also excluded from the privilege of participating in commencement ceremonies. We are asking for both student and parent cooperation in following these necessary rules, as it would be a shame to ruin a very special evening because of a violation.
