February 14th - Pick up diapers (family educator will deliver at scheduled visit)

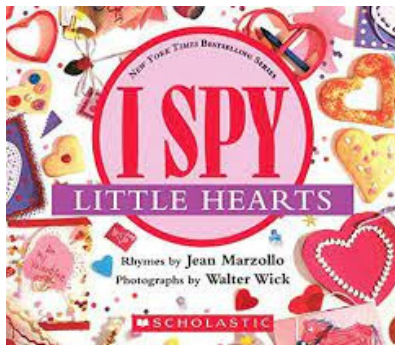

## BOOK SUGGESTION



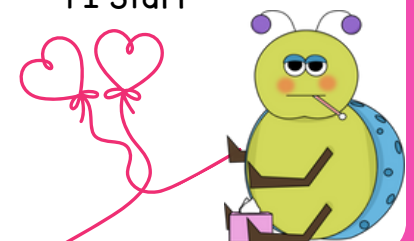
Reading and storytelling helps children learn about sounds, words, and language. Reading stories stimulates imagination, develops social skills, and helps children learn about the world.
