

Camino Real Middle School Dress Code

PURPOSE: To ensure that a student's dress or appearance does not disrupt or disturb the educational process nor shall constitute a threat to health or safety to themselves or to others.

- No dresses, skirts or shorts shorter than midhigh (use the extended finger rule). No spandex/volleyball shorts allowed.
- No spaghetti straps, tube tops, or razorbacks allowed. In addition, if this type of top is concealed by a hoodie or sweater, the top must not be exposed at any time.
- Neckline tops must be modest to conceal all private parts in material that is not see through.
- No pajamas allowed.
- Tops must have a shoulder strap width of 2" (2 finger width).
- No offensive logos, images, or text statements/graphics are allowed on clothing. This extends to both written text and logos that are known to be associated with hate groups. In addition, this also includes drug paraphernalia, pornographic images, contains threats, promotes illegal or violent conduct, gang affiliation, the unlawful use of weapons, drugs, alcohol, vaping, or tobacco.
- No bandanas are allowed.
- No visible pocket watch/wallet chains over garments allowed.
- Slippers are prohibited.
- No exposed stomach areas are allowed through crop tops. All shirts must be long enough to clearly overlap the beltline or stay tucked in. (Raising arms over your head should not allow for your stomach area to be displayed)
- Undergarments must remain entirely covered. This applies to underwear exposed from pants and shorts, as well as bras. Distressed or torn jeans may not expose undergarments.
- Hats, caps and sunglasses must not be worn indoors. Caps and sunglasses are permitted outside the building only for sun protection.
- Hoods or beanies must not be worn while inside the building.
- Students must be identifiable by staff to where their face and hair is not concealed. This does not include clothing/headgear worn for religious or medical purposes or face coverings worn in response to a health crisis. Permission must be provided for specific medical circumstances pertaining to head coverings.
- Should student be dress coded for inappropriate dress, and not have an appropriate change of clothing, student will be placed in In-School-Suspension until appropriate dress can be achieved.
- Students must also follow the District Dress Code Policy - JICA-R referenced on District website.
