## **Superintendent's Report and Recommendation:**

- Attendance Report:
  - Our elementary attendance winner for the first month is West End Elementary School, at 96.71%.
  - Our secondary attendance winner for the first month is Rome Middle School, at 95.23%.
  - Our staff attendance winner for the first month is Main Elementary School, at 98.95%.
  - The overall attendance rate for Rome City Schools for the first month is 94.0%.

## - Personnel Report:

- On a Blanchard/Fisher motion, the Board unanimously approved Dr. Holland's personnel recommendations for employment for the 2023-2024 school year.

## - ESPLOST V:

- Director of Finance, Mr. Greg Studdard, presented the ESPLOST V receipts for the tax period of August 2023, which indicate the actual amount collected was \$847,738. The anticipated ESPLOST amount was \$505,300. We had a positive variance of \$342,438.

- Dr. Holland gave a special shout-out to Mr. Andrew Wilfong of West Central Elementary School, Rome City Schools' Exemplary Teacher of the Year, Mr. Alvin Powell of Rome Middle School, Rome City Schools' Support Professional of the Year, and to Mrs. Laura Walley, Rome City Schools' Exemplary Leader of the Year.
- Spotlight on West End Elementary School, Principal, Dr. Dennis Drummond:
  - Dr. Drummond began his presentation by acknowledging and thanking all West End teachers, staff, students, and parents in attendance. He shared information about West End in connection to the four pillars (Student Achievement, Staff Development, Stakeholder, Engagement, and Safety & Operations) and Strategic Area Goals 1.1, 1.2, 2.1, 3.1, 3.2, 4.1, and 4.2). Dr. Drummond highlighted his students work in multiple areas and specifically with WEE Cooks and through a STEM presentation.

- Mr. Chris Twyman explained that the Rome City Schools' Board of Education was being asked to adopt a resolution to ratify the Rome Building Authority's bond resolution to provide for revenue bonds to finance construction of Rome Middle School and, additionally, being asked to adopt an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Rome. On a Burge/Blanchard motion, the Board members unanimously approved the bond resolution and adopted the resolution for the Intergovernmental Contract between Rome City and the Rome City Board of Education.

- Mrs. Collins explained that it was time for the Board to appoint a legislative liaison for the 2023-2024 school year. Mr. Jackson was the liaison last year, and he has graciously volunteered to be the liaison again this year. Mrs. Collins expressed to Mr. Jackson the Board's thanks.
