- ESPLOST V:

- Director of Finance, Mr. Greg Studdard, presented the ESPLOST V receipts for the tax period of October 2023, which indicate the actual amount collected was \$699,660. The anticipated ESPLOST amount was \$505,300. We had a positive variance of \$194,360.
