Semester Testing Reminders:

- Tuesday, January 16 is the start of the Review sessions. The only review sessions for Period 1 and 2 is on Tuesday, January 16. Periods 3-7 will have the first part of their review on January 16 and the rest of the time will come throughout the week. These times are noted in the schedule above.
- Students must attend Review sessions for Study Hall and Teacher Aides. This includes any time on the schedule that says Review. For example, students in Study Hall or Teacher Aide's 5th period have to attend their review time on Tuesday, January 16th (36 min) and also on Wednesday, January 17th (35 min) for a total of 71 minutes of Review.
- Students do not have to attend Study Hall during their scheduled testing time. Students are also not required to attend their Teacher Aide scheduled testing time, unless they are receiving partial credit (Office Aide and Library Aide). Office Aides and Library Aides must attend both their scheduled Review sessions and their scheduled Testing sessions.
- Students at no time will be released early from their Review and/or Testing sessions. Please make sure that you encourage students to bring reading material/study material to each testing session. If students finish early and need to finish a test in another class, please make sure they get a pink pass prior to the start of your class.
- There will be no bells during Semester Finals. Please pay attention to when it is time to transition.
- On Friday, January 19, if students have completed all of their finals they do not have to return to school after lunch. If they missed a final or need extra time to complete a final, there will be a make-up session from 12:50 pm – 2:30 pm on Friday, January 19. Students can be released when they are finished with their make-up final(s). All staff will be available during this time.
- If students skip the make-up session, or do not complete all finals by Friday, January 19 they will receive a zero for their Semester final(s). **If there are extenuating circumstances that prevents a student from completing all of their finals by Friday, January 19, parents need to call the Assistant Principal and make arrangements for the student to make-up their final during a different time.**
