

Attendance

Chronic absence — missing 10 percent or more of school days due to absence for any reason— excused, unexcused absences and suspensions, can translate into sixth-graders failing subjects and ninth-graders dropping out of high school.

Co-Curricular Activities -

Engagement in enrichment and extracurricular activities can enhance students' academic performance. Early awareness and exposure to a wide range of enrichment and extracurricular activities form a foundation upon which students can build their future aspirations and interests.

3.0 GPA

Students' middle school grades are a crucial point of intervention. Students with a 3.0 GPA in middle school are predicted to earn higher grades in high school.

Core Classes

Of all indicators tested, eighth grade core GPA is the best predictor being on track at the end of ninth-grade and of passing particular subjects. Seventh grade core GPA is similarly as predictive of being on track in ninth grade is eighth grade core GPA.

Self-Regulation

WI DPI Dropout Early Warning System (DEWS) scores are available for all students in grades 6 through 9 beginning in 2012-13. The DEWS score is a number from 0-100 that represents the probability of a student graduating within 4 years of entering high school. The DEWS score is calculated individually for each student and represents how often similar students graduated high school on schedule in prior years. The DEWS score is broken into three categories of risk – high, moderate, and low risk.

Identified Academic and Career Plan

Current national research indicates that students who engage in high quality ACP activities are more likely to persist in school and stay engaged in school activities well as enjoy a greater overall sense of belonging and connectedness to school.

Advanced and Proficient on Forward Exam

During the 2015-16 school year, Wisconsin rolled out a new assessment called the Wisconsin Forward Exam. The Exam is designed to gauge how well students are doing in relation to the Wisconsin Academic Standards. These standards outline what students should know and be able to do in order to be college and career ready. The Forward Exam is administered online in the spring of each school year at:

- grades 3-8 in English Language Arts (ELA) and mathematics,
- grades 4 and 8 in Science and,
- grades 4, 8, and 10 in Social Studies.
