- Accepted for enrollment at a university or technical college
- Provide 2 letters of recommendation. (One from outside the school community...no coaches, parents, teachers, or family members, and one from inside the school community...coach, principal or teacher) These letters should include information about your character (for all 4 years), work ethic, service, willingness to help others and drive for success)
- Provide an activity sheet listing all extra-curricular activities, years of involvement and leadership roles held
- Submit complete application
