FSA IDs/FAFSA: GVHS encourages ALL seniors to create their FSA Ids, complete the FAFSA, and to narrow down their college admission options. In November, we will encourage students to complete their college applications. Information on the FSA Ids was also distributed to all seniors closer to the December window of the FAFSA opening for the Fall of 2024 students. them a courtesy email (or talk to them in person) explaining the impending task. :)
